Deadline for Entry: April 30, 2021

The iOme Challenge is a national student competition designed to confront status quo thinking about the nation's current retirement system and how future programs could be improved or replaced to help ensure the future financial security of American workers and their families.

To enter:

- 1.** Imagine life 40 or 50 years from now. Will retirement be an option? Will you have planned ahead? Saved? What public policies could be enacted today to help ensure a secure financial future for today's students fifty years from now.
- 2.** Students: Form a team and select a faculty advisor (it's ok to work on your own!)
Faculty: Encourage a team to form
- 3.** Visit www.iomechallenge.org to see the 2021 iOme Challenge question and register to enter.
- 4.** After consultation and deliberation, submit an essay with your ideas in response to the Challenge question. Essays must meet the guidelines outlined on the iOme website.
- 5.** Deadline for submission: April 30, 2021

Essays will be judged by a blue-ribbon panel. The winner will be announced by May 17, 2021.
